

Engine 72 Takes a Ride on the Southside

Just after 1100hrs units from the 3rd and 5th battalions were working on the scene of a house fire causing Engine 72 to be transferred to company 29, Silver Hill. After arriving at company 29, Engine 72 responded on a couple locals and were on their way back to station 29, when they were dispatched as the first due engine for the house fire in the 2300blk of Curtis Dr. Engine 72 quickly arrived on the scene, finding smoke showing, taking their own hydrant, and deploying the crosslay into the house. The crew from Engine 72 found the basement stairs and made the decision to make the stairs. The crew found a fire in the basement and quickly made a knock on the fire. Command started scaling back the assignment in under 30 minutes and Engine 72 remained on the scene assisting the Fire Marshall's Office until 1430hrs. Engine 72 finally made it home around 1500hrs.
